Key note address:



The keynote address of the conference was unique of the type. **Dr. Vivek Sawant** gave demonstration of learning management systems “**Super Campus**” Developed by MKCL. He started his address by quoting the mobile phones are not allowed in the classrooms in most of the education institutes but super campus is the application which will compel educational institutions to make the mobiles compulsory in the classrooms for teaching learning. The app will enable teaching learning process to convert information into the knowledge and will help to convert people in to the learning community to the ever learning community.

He said that some teachers are repressive teachers some are impressive teachers and some are manifestive teachers. Teaching is not merely giving information but let the student’s synthesis knowledge by analyzing the information. The psychology treats students as adolescents but they must be treated as adults while teaching. The teaching learning process must be adult to adult interaction. It is the duty of teacher to convert the students into effective lifelong learner.

He further explained super campus as creative imaginative application of mobile facilitating the teaching learning process. The class room can be turned into ICT classroom without internet and projector so the app can be used along with mobiles with minimum expenses and hence is suitable for the institutions with minimum infrastructure.

He said “Every child is special “and animation can be particularly useful for remedial teaching. He asked teachers to think about teaching as religion and not a profession. He discussed about the purpose of animation in academics is to accomplish a cognitive function. The animations are helpful to support students’ cognitive processes that ultimately result in them understanding the subject matter. They can be used to make lecture very exciting and fun, the difficult concepts can easily be incorporated. Teachers can also use animation to demonstrate things and concepts visually exactly how they want to since they have control of every aspect of the animation. It can be used to show how things come together and work together. As an affective learning tool that attracts attention, engages the learner, and creates motivation facet. He demonstrated how Animation is used in presentation to make it effective and live by using various ICT tools like Online Image Editor, Video Scribe, white Board Animation, Prezi Software and Academic Presenter etc. This was really a creative, knowledgeable and feel of hands on experience session.
